Important news about the way we dial — Beginning October 24, 2021, everyone in the 618 area code must dial 10 digits (area code + telephone number) for all local calls. In addition, all services or automatic dialing equipment must be re-programmed to use the 10-digit numbers. This change will enable a new, nationwide emergency number (988) for the National Suicide Prevention and Mental Health Crisis Lifeline, which will go into effect July 16, 2022.
