**The Circuit Tre Ore** (pronounced “Trey OR-ay”) service will be held at Immanuel Augsburg on Good Friday, April 15, at noon. This service directs our attention to the three hours of agony during which our Lord hung upon the cross. (“Tre Ore” means “Three Hours.”) Our contemplation – meditating upon the Seven Words Spoken by Christ

from the Cross – is relatively recent (only about 350 years old). Our liturgy has been tailored to permit pilgrims to come and go as they are able. Following a brief opening liturgy, each of the Seven Words is contained in its own 20- 25 minute devotional service-within-the-service, and then a brief concluding liturgy shapes the bundle into one cohesive unit.
