LWML SUNDAY

Ladies of the congregation are encouraged to support the mission work of the LWML by taking part in the MITE offering today. The 2022-2023 Mission goal of the CID LWML is \$105,00.00. Seventy five percent will go toward the CID grants and remaining will go toward the National grants. Below is a list of the CID grants which will be paid off in the order listed.

- 1. Student Aid for Church Workers-----\$30,000**
With education costly, this grant provides partial funding to CID students to help compete their schooling. These funds are distributed through the LCMS CID scholarship committee.
- 2. Orphan Grain Train Shipping-----\$9,000**
Orphan Grain Train collects, gathers, and then distributes quilts, dresses, medical mobility equipment, layettes, hygiene, school supplies, and Christ centered literature around the world. These funds, sent to the Nebraska center, will sponsor shipping a full container overseas.
- 3. Orphan Grain Train Supplies-----\$8,100**
St. Louis based Orphan Grain Train distributes food and household items to nearly a dozen LCMS area congregational pantries which are then distributed to the needy in their communities on a weekly basis. This grant will be used to replenish these items and also cover some of the operational and utilities cost at the St. Louis location.
- 4. Beyond the Classroom in CID Schools-----\$7,500**
Schools are considered a major outreach by most churches. *Beyond the Classroom* will help schools and congregations review, evaluate and develop their outreach activities. This grant will provide the opportunity to develop a three year program of three phases. Phase 1 would include informational sessions about the program. Phase 2 centers on recruiting and training facilitators, and phase 3 where those facilitators would offer workshops to CID churches with schools. This grant is funded through the CID office.
- 5. Family Life Center in Effingham-----\$5,000**
Enabled by this grant, the Family Life Center will provide material needs, education and support to women, men and families experiencing pregnancy, parenting and related issues helping them to live abundant lives.
- 6. Sterling Lutheran Church, Alaska-----\$3,500**
Communication and transportation can be difficult in Alaska, especially when serving a dual parish. This grant will provide a technology upgrade with a desktop computer, printer and internet service that will help the Rev. and Mrs. Bill Hilgendorf in their mission of serving a dual parish.
- 7. Support for missionary Hayden Rensner in Czech Republic-----\$10,000**
This grant will enable Hayden Rensner in her missionary work in the Czech Republic. Being responsible for her own living and travel expenses during her service. These funds will help cover some of those cost.
- 8. Textbooks for Concordia Preparatory School in Ghana-----\$5,650**
Begun in 2012 this school has grown to over 1,000 students, many with Muslin background. Recent requirements for the curriculum by the government make necessary new textbooks in the area of Math, English, Science, Computing, History, Social Studies, Culture and Religious and Moral Education. It is a great struggle to finance these books with the current result being the sharing of 1 book by 4 or 5 students.

Pray that all our grants are funded and God's word is spread in correctness and abundance throughout the world.
