**Dollar for Missions:** A Dollar for Missions gathers many small gifts – one dollar at a time! – to add up to a big impact for the spread of the saving Gospel of Christ. Our current project is to help a campus congregation, University Lutheran Church in Champaign, to purchase a 12-passenger van. Project cost: \$35,000.
