

# April 2005 Voter's Meeting Minutes

Quarterly Meeting

April 17, 2005

Chairman Nelson Torbeck called the meeting to order. The Sexton, Senior Youth Group and the Junior Youth Group had nothing to report at this time. The Men of the Congregation have been meeting informally and doing what needs doing. The Finance men had nothing to report.

The Constitution Committee reported on their work. A motion to adopt the proposed amended Constitution received a second and carried. The proposed amended Constitution will be sent to the Central Illinois District for review.
