

Quarterly Voters Meeting

October 10, 2010

Chairman Charles Kruenegel called the meeting to order. Pastor Bruce gave a brief opening from First Corinthians and led those present in prayer. The minutes were read and accepted as read. There were no releases or new members at this time. The Treasurer's report was accepted as read.

The Chairman appointed Nelson Torbeck, Dennis Schukar, and Dennis Meseke as tellers for the elections. Jerry Schukar was appointed as temporary secretary.

The Elders reported meeting with Pastor Bruce and things are going well. The Trustees reported that the drain line has been completed. A motion to accept a janitorial bid from Allen and Marsha Sasse for \$11,000 (\$400 more than 2010) received a second and passed. The Trustees suggested a budget of \$9,000 for Missions and \$120,000 for home. A motion to this effect received a second and carried. \$14,700 remains from the Ralph Schaal Estate.

The Board of Education had nothing to report at this time. The Sunday School has great teachers and staff and will begin the Christmas program practice soon. The Bible class is studying First and Second Peter and encourages more to attend. The Sextant will spend \$5721 to fix all of the worst stones. Pastor Bruce will start a Youth Group and will be holding several social events with them. Friends are also welcome to attend.

The Finance Men had no report at this time. Pastor Bruce was given a rising vote of thanks for his hard work visiting members and shut-ins and for his two confirmation classes this year.

A motion to accept the Council's recommendation received a second and carried.

A motion to have the Trustees buy padded chairs for the Bible Class using money from the Ralph Schaal Estate received a second and passed. Pastor Bruce was excused for salary discussions. The Council recommended a \$2,000 increase to the Pastor's salary. After some discussion, a motion to accept the Council's recommendation for a \$2,000 raise for Pastor Bruce passed.
